	<ul> <li>Description:</li> <li>On Public-Private Partnership (P3) and AFP projects that necessitate an Independent Quality Assurance Firm [IQAF] role, ACEC-Ontario requested that IQAF experience be recognized by MTO as equivalent to CA role on MTO jobs.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Discussion:</li> <li>MTO shared proposed language in CA RFP and EOI Long Form with ACEC-Ontario prior to this meeting, received ACEC-Ontario's comments, and adjusted IQAF language based on their comments.</li> <li>ACEC-Ontario suggested if IQAF language could be standard in all assignments, rather than added on a project-by-project basis. MTO agreed to evaluate the suggestion. Regardless, both MTO and ACEC-Ontario were agreeable with the language being proposed.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Discussion:</li> <li>MTO clarified previous correspondence regarding experience requirements for low complexity assignments.</li> <li>ACEC-Ontario acknowledged MTO's position of qualification criteria for medium and high complexity assignments, but that further conversation is needed in overall succession management discussions.</li> <li>ACEC-Ontario suggested if the MTO could investigate having the TLT 131, Advance Issue Resolution Course, more often. Identifying that registry is required months in advance and that registration is not guaranteed. Currently the course is offered once, annually.</li> <li>MTO acknowledged the concern and will explore further options.</li> </ul>

# Discussion: MTO identified it received ACEC-Ontario's comments on the CA RFP document shared through the working group and that these comments have been shared with internal committees for review. ACEC-Ontario identified that the selection of staff should be aligned with the overall succession management plan. Both MTO and ACEC-Ontario acknowledged that after MTO internal review, any changes to the CA TOR should be reviewed by the working aroup. ACEC-Ontario identified that from previous discussions, it is working towards providing a reasonable number of low complexity opportunities needed to gain experience and support succession management. ACEC-Ontario and MTO agreed that any further discussions for CA qualification criteria would continue under the overall succession management item. MTO/ACEC-ON **Action** – ACEC-Ontario to provide MTO with a reasonable number of low complexity assignments. MTO to provide an update of internal review of the CA assignment documents. Jun-24-09 **AGENDA ITEM: DEBRIEF PROCESS** Description: ACEC-Ontario raised concern on the level of feedback and inconsistency being provided during the debrief process. Discussion: MTO clarified that it will not be providing proponent's scores and ranking in the debrief process for Engineering and CA assignments. ACEC-Ontario identified it would still like to be provided this information but acknowledged MTO's position. Both ACEC-Ontario and MTO agreed that training could bring about better feedback and consistency during the debrief process. Action: Item closed.
